A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR, OR DESIGNEE, TO EXECUTE AN EXTENSION OF THE AGREEMENT FOR COOPERATIVE EXTENSION SERVICES BETWEEN ST. JOHNS COUNTY AND THE UNIVERSITY OF FLORIDA, BOARD OF TRUSTEES; PROVIDING FOR THE EFFECT OF RECITALS; PROVIDING FOR THE CORRECTION OF ERRORS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

RECITALS

WHEREAS, St. Johns County and the University of Florida entered into an Agreement for Cooperative Extension Services (the Agreement) on October 3, 2017 in order to provide for the planning and implementation of educational demonstrations and programs for growers, families, homeowners, and young people within St. Johns County; and

WHEREAS, the Agreement shall terminate on September 30, 2021; and

WHEREAS, certain projects funded under the Agreement are still ongoing, due to a misalignment between cropping cycles and the County fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, in certain incidences, crops have been harvested, but additional time is required for data collection, analysis, and reporting; and

WHEREAS, the County and the University desire to extend the Agreement for the purpose of concluding the ongoing projects

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, THAT:

SECTION 1. Incorporation of Recitals.

The Recitals expressed above are incorporated by reference into the body of this Resolution, and such Recitals are hereby adopted as findings of fact.

SECTION 2. Authorization to Execute.

The County Administrator, or designee, is hereby authorized to execute an extension of the Agreement for Cooperative Extension Services between the County and the University of Florida, Board of Trustees, substantially in the same form as attached.

SECTION 3. Correction of Errors.

To the extent that there are typographical and/or administrative errors and/or omissions that do not change the tone, tenor, or context of this Resolution, then this Resolution may be revised without subsequent approval of the Board of County Commissioners.

SECTION 4. Effective Date.

This Resolution shall be effective upon execution by the Chair of the Board of County Commissioners.
