

RESOLUTION NO. 2021-490

A RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE STANDARDIZATION OF MUSCO SPORTS LIGHTING EQUIPMENT FOR ST. JOHNS COUNTY PARKS AND RECREATION FACILITIES.

RECITALS

WHEREAS, the County seeks to standardize the use of Musco Sports Lighting equipment throughout St. Johns County Parks and Recreation facilities in order to have consistent and equal sports lighting equipment in all park facilities; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the St. Johns County Purchasing Manual, the County may standardize equipment for compatibility with existing equipment, safety, ease of maintenance, and cost of additional training if different equipment is purchased; and

WHEREAS, Parks and Recreation has purchased and installed Musco Sports lighting in nineteen park facilities since 1997; and

WHEREAS, all purchases of Musco Sports Lighting equipment will be funded by SJC Parks and Recreation, unless alternative funding sources are identified for a specific purchase; and

WHEREAS, the County finds that standardizing this equipment serves a public purpose.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, as follows:

Section 1. The above recitals are hereby incorporated into the body of this resolution and are adopted as findings of fact.

Section 2. The Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County Florida approves Musco Sports Lighting equipment as the standard sports lighting equipment for St. Johns County Parks & Recreation facilities.

Section 3. The County Administrator, or designee, is authorized to specify and/or purchase Musco Sports Lighting equipment as the County's standard equipment for sports lighting until such time as the BOCC rescinds this authorization.

Section 4. The County Administrator, or designee, is further authorized to issue and execute purchase orders or contract agreements for Musco Sports Lighting equipment, without further BOCC approval, provided the funds needed for the purchase have been legally appropriated by the BOCC.

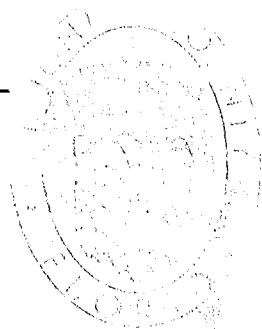
