## RESOLUTION NO. 2022-144

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA ALTERING THE VOTING PRECINCTS IN ST. JOHNS COUNTY PURSUANT TO SECTION 101.001(1), FLORIDA STATUTES, BASED UPON THE RECOMMENDATION AND APPROVAL OF THE SUPERVISOR OF ELECTIONS, AS A RESULT OF REDISTRICTING.

## **RECITALS**

WHEREAS, Article VIII, Section 1(e), of the Florida Constitution requires that after each decennial census the Board of County Commissioners shall divide the County into districts of contiguous territory as nearly equal in population as practicable. One commissioner residing in each district shall be elected as provided by law; and

WHERAS, due to the recent decennial redistricting, the voting precincts in St. Johns County need to be altered; and

WHEREAS, Florida Statutes §101.001(1) states that the Board of County Commissioners, upon recommendation and approval of the Supervisor of Elections, shall alter or create precincts for voting in the county; and

WHEREAS, Florida Statutes §101.001(1) requires that the altered precincts shall be numbered and, as nearly as practicable, composed of contiguous and compact areas; and

WHEREAS, the Supervisor has recommended and approved the proposed voting precincts attached hereto as Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, the Board has reviewed the proposed voting precincts recommended and approved by the Supervisor and finds that they are numbered, are composed of contiguous and compact areas, and are in compliance with applicable law.

## NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, THAT:

- **Section 1**. The above recitals are incorporated by reference into the body of this Resolution and such recitals are adopted as findings of fact.
- **Section 2.** The voting precincts in St. Johns County are hereby altered, as recommended by the Supervisor of Elections. The new voting precincts are attached hereto as Exhibit A.
- Section 3. To the extent that there are typographical, scriveners or administrative errors that do not change the tone, tenor, or concept of this Resolution, then this Resolution may be revised without subsequent approval by the Board of County Commissioners.
