

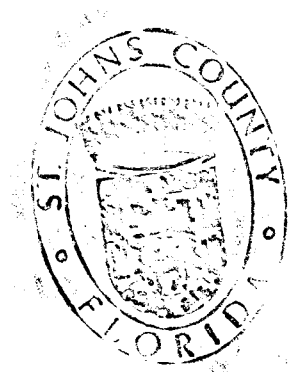

Description of Property Being Vacated
