A RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, APPROVING ACQUISITION OF PROPERTY FROM THE STATE OF FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION NEAR RAY ROAD AND VAN GOGH CIRCLE FOR A FUTURE WELL SITE.

RECITALS

WHEREAS, the State of Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) owns certain vacant property located near Ray Road and Van Gogh Circle; and

WHEREAS, said property is no longer required by the FDOT for transportation purposes; and

WHEREAS, this property is an ideal location for a future well site due to its proximity to the existing water treatment plant located at Ray Road; and

WHEREAS, the County has made application to the FDOT to execute and deliver a Deed in favor of St. Johns County, Florida, conveying all rights, title and interest that the FDOT has in and to said lands; and

WHEREAS, the FDOT has determined it is in the best interest of the public to convey this property to St. Johns County for use as a future well site or other utility purposes, and has agreed to provide a Quitclaim Deed in the same form and format as Exhibit "A", attached hereto and by reference incorporated herein; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the public to acquire this property for the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of St. Johns County.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, as follows:

1. The above Recitals are incorporated by reference into the body of this Resolution and such Recitals are adopted as findings of fact.

- 2. The Board of County Commissioners hereby approve the acquisition of this property and instructs staff to take whatever action is necessary in order to complete this purchase in compliance with applicable Florida law.
- 3. To the extent that there are typographical, scriveners or administrative errors that <u>do</u> <u>not</u> change the tone, tenor, or concept of this Resolution, then this Resolution may be revised without subsequent approval by the Board of County Commissioners.
