OF COUNTY THE **BOARD** RESOLUTION \mathbf{BY} ST. JOHNS COUNTY, COMMISSIONERS OF FLORIDA. ACCEPTING A TEMPORARY CONSTRUCTION EASEMENT FOR ROADWAY AND SIDEWALK IMPROVEMENTS ALONG HOLMES BOULEVARD AND KING STREET EXTENSION.

RECITALS

WHEREAS, The School Board of St. Johns County, Florida, has executed and presented to the County a Temporary Construction Easement for roadway and sidewalk improvements along North Holmes Boulevard and King Street Extension, attached hereto as Exhibit "A", incorporated by reference and made a part hereof; and

WHEREAS, the Temporary Construction Easement is necessary for the County to construct roadway and sidewalk improvements along North Holmes Boulevard and King Street Extension; and

WHEREAS, the sidewalk improvements will create a continuous pedestrian connection from West King Street northerly along North Holmes Boulevard to Four Mile Road; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the County to accept the Temporary Construction Easement for the health, safety and welfare of its citizens.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, as follows:

- Section 1. The above recitals are incorporated by reference into the body of this Resolution and such recitals are adopted as findings of fact.
- Section 2. The above described Temporary Construction Easement, attached and incorporated hereto, is hereby accepted by the Board of County Commissioners.
- Section 3. To the extent that there are typographical, scriveners or administrative errors that <u>do not</u> change the tone, tenor, or concept of this Resolution, then this Resolution may be revised without subsequent approval by the Board of County Commissioners.

Section 4. The Clerk of the Circuit Court is instructed to record the original Temporary Construction Easement from The School Board of St. Johns County, Florida in the Public Records of St. Johns County, Florida.

TEMPORARY CONSTRUCTION EASEMENT

THIS TEMPORARY CONSTRUCTION EASEMENT made this 3 day of September 2022, by THE SCHOOL BOARD OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, whose address is 40 Orange Street, St. Augustine, Florida 32084 (Grantor) and ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, whose address is 500 San Sebastian View, St. Augustine, Florida 32084 (Grantee).

WITNESSETH that for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable considerations, receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, the Grantor hereby gives, grants, bargains and releases to the Grantee or its designee, a Temporary Construction Easement to enter upon and use the Grantor's Property as described below for the purpose of constructing roadway improvements, sidewalks, and all appurtenances incidental thereto, as well as related infrastructure construction. All improvements to take place along the Holmes Boulevard, and along and within the boundary of the Grantor's below-described Property. This Easement is over land in St. Johns County, Florida, described as follows:

See attached Exhibit A, incorporated by reference herein (the Property).

Grantor retains the reasonable right to use all or part of this Temporary Construction Easement as Grantor deems appropriate, and subject to the reasonable concurrence of Grantee to accommodate school purposes during the term of this Temporary Construction Easement.

Grantee shall ensure that all persons on the Property pursuant to the rights given under this Temporary Construction Easement at any time when students are present on the Property comply with noninstructional contractor requirements set forth by ss. 1012.465, .467 and .468, Fla. Stat.

As to the Temporary Construction Easement, Grantee shall be liable to Grantor for any consequential or direct damages, and Grantee indemnifies and holds Grantor harmless, all to the extent authorized by s. 768.28, Fla. Stat., for damages or declaratory, injunctive, criminal or administrative liability, related to the Temporary Construction Easement, except for and to the extent caused by negligence, recklessness or intentional misconduct of Grantor. Grantee's

responsibility for the Temporary Construction Easement includes, but is not limited to, compliance with all federal, state and local laws, rules, ordinances and policies concerning environmental and natural resources, except as limited by this paragraph.

Grantee may assign its rights in whole or in part, under this Temporary Construction Easement, but only with prior written approval of Grantor, such approval not to be unreasonably withheld. Any assignee of any of Grantee's rights must, at a minimum: (1) provide liability insurance certificate in favor of Grantor' of \$1,000,000 per incident and \$3,000,000 overall; and (2) indemnify Grantor on the same terms as Grantee does in this Temporary Construction Easement, but without any limitation under s. 768.28, Fla. Stat.

It is understood and agreed by the parties hereto that the rights granted herein shall terminate after a period of three hundred sixty-five (365) days from the date of execution of this Temporary Construction Easement, unless earlier terminated in the reasonable, joint determination of the parties that the purposes of this Temporary Construction Easement have been met.
