

RESOLUTION NO. 2023 131

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, RECOGNIZING AND APPROPRIATING A U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY FEMA GRANT AND A STATE OF FLORIDA DIVISION OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT GRANT WITHIN THE FISCAL YEAR 2023 GENERAL FUND, BUILDING SERVICES FUND, TRANSPORTATION TRUST FUND, FIRE DISTRICT FUND, SOLID WASTE FUND, AND UTILITY SYSTEM FUND FOR DAMAGES RELATING TO HURICANES IAN AND NICOLE AND AUTHORIZING RESERVE TRANSFERS FROM FROM EACH OF THESE FUNDS TO SATISFY THE LOCAL MATCH REQUIREMENT.

WHEREAS, Hurricanes Ian and Nicole inflicted severe impacts to Florida resulting in a presidential declaration for federal assistance in St. Johns County; and

WHEREAS, the County sustained damages from Hurricanes Ian and Nicole and is responsible for repairs to public property; and

WHEREAS, the County estimates the eligible costs for repairs to be \$3,682,464 related to Hurricanes Ian and Nicole; and

WHEREAS, it is estimated that the County will receive up to \$2,761,848 from a Department of Homeland Security FEMA grant related to Hurricanes Ian and Nicole which necessitates a County match of \$460,308; and

WHEREAS, reserve transfers from the General Fund, Building Services Fund, Transportation Trust Fund, Fire District Fund, Solid Waste Fund, and Utility System Fund are necessary to provide the County match, and

WHEREAS, it is estimated that the County will receive up to \$460,308 from a State of Florida Division of Emergency Management grant; and

WHEREAS, the County did not anticipate either an award of a Department of Homeland Security FEMA grant or a State of Florida Division of Emergency Management grant related to Hurricanes Ian and Nicole during the Fiscal Year 2023 budget process; and


WHEREAS, the County must recognize and appropriate \$2,761,848 from a FEMA grant and \$460,308 from a State of Florida Division of Emergency Management grant within the collective Fiscal Year 2023 General Fund, Building Services Fund, Transportation Trust Fund, Fire District Fund, Solid Waste Fund, and Utility System Fund budgets.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida:

1. The above recitals are hereby adopted as legislative findings of fact and incorporated herein.
2. The Board of County Commissioners recognizes and appropriates a tentative Department of Homeland Security FEMA grant for up to \$2,761,848 and a tentative State of Florida Division of Emergency Management grant for up to \$460,308 related to Hurricanes Ian and Nicole within the Fiscal Year 2023 Budget.
3. The Board of County Commissioners authorizes reserve transfers from the General Fund, Building Services Fund, Transportation Trust Fund, Fire District Fund, Solid Waste Fund, and Utility System Fund to satisfy the \$460,308 local match requirement.
4. To the extent there are typographical errors that do not substantively change the tone, tenor, or concept of this resolution, this resolution may be revised without subsequent approval by the Board of County Commissioners.


