

**RESOLUTION NO. 2024 - 252**

A RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, RENEWING THIRTY-SIX (36) NON-EXCLUSIVE FRANCHISES FOR THE COLLECTION AND TRANSPORTATION OF NON-RESIDENTIAL SOLID WASTE.

**RECITALS**

**WHEREAS**, St. Johns County Ordinance 17-39 (“Ordinance”) requires all persons engaging in the business of collecting or transporting solid waste from any real property in the County, who are not exempt, to receive a franchise from the County; and

**WHEREAS**, all existing non-exclusive franchises expire on June 30, 2024, unless a timely renewal application is submitted demonstrating compliance with the Ordinance and the franchise agreement; and

**WHEREAS**, thirty-six (36) existing non-exclusive franchise holders have timely submitted for renewal and the Solid Waste Division reviewed the applications and recommends renewing the franchises; and

**WHEREAS**, based on Board’s consideration of the applications and the applicable criteria in the Ordinance, the Board desires to renew the non-exclusive franchises; and

**WHEREAS**, renewing the non-exclusive franchises, subject to terms and conditions of franchise agreements, is necessary for the protection of the public health, safety, and welfare, and is in best interest of the County; now, therefore

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida:

**Section 1.** The above Recitals are hereby incorporated into the body of this Resolution, and are adopted as findings of fact.


**Section 2.** In accordance with Ordinance 17-39, the County Administrator, or her designee, is authorized to issue non-exclusive franchise agreements for the collection and transportation of construction and demolition debris to the 36 existing franchise holders qualified for renewal.

**Section 3.** To the extent that there are typographical, administrative, or scrivener’s errors that do not change the tone, tenor, or context of this Resolution, then this Resolution may be revised without further action by the Board of County Commissioners.


