

**RESOLUTION NO. 2024 – 259**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE SHERIFF, OR DESIGNEE, TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION SEEKING FUNDING ASSISTANCE THROUGH THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF LAW ENFORCEMENT (OFFICE OF JUSTICE PROGRAMS) – FEDERAL FISCAL YEAR 2023 EDWARD BYRNE MEMORIAL JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT COUNTYWIDE (JAG-C), PROGRAM IN WHICH THE CHAIR HAS AUTHORIZED AND EXECUTED A CERTIFICATION OF PARTICIPATION AND 51% LETTER ON BEHALF OF THE COUNTY.**

**RECITALS**

**WHEREAS**, the Florida Department of Law Enforcement anticipates an award from the Office of Justice Programs through the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG-C) Program: Local Solicitation allocates funding in the amount of \$77,658 for St. Johns County; and

**WHEREAS**, JAG funded projects may be used by St. Johns County local units of government to support a broad range of activities to prevent and control crime and to improve the criminal justice system; and

**WHEREAS**, the St. Johns County Sheriff's Office, together with the City of St. Augustine Police Department and the City of St. Augustine Beach Police Department are requesting to use the grant funding for equipment totaling \$77,658; and

**WHEREAS**, the Florida Department of Law Enforcement requires the Board of County Commissioners to authorize their acceptance through a Certificate of Participation and 51% letter; and

**WHEREAS**, after a review of the Grant announcement materials, the County has determined that nothing contained in the Grant application negatively impacts the interests of the County; and

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA**, as follows:

**Section 1.** The above Recitals are incorporated by reference into the body of this Resolution, and such Recitals are adopted as Findings of Fact.

**Section 2.** The Board of County Commissioners hereby approves and authorizes the Sheriff of St. Johns County, Florida, or his designee, to submit an application seeking funding assistance through the Florida Department of Law Enforcement - Fiscal Year 2023 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG-C) and to execute any other paperwork necessary to, or associated with, the grant application.

**Section 3.** The Board of County Commissioners hereby authorizes the Chair's execution of the attached Certificate of Participation and 51% letter on behalf of the County.

**Section 4.** To the extent that there are typographical or administrative errors or omissions that do not change the tone, tenor, or context of this Resolution, this Resolution may be revised without subsequent approval of the Board of County Commissioners.



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
