RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, RECOGNIZING AND APPROPRIATING A US DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY FEMA GRANT, A STATE OF FLORIDA DIVISION OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT GRANT, AND THE COUNTYS LOCAL SHARE WITHIN THE FISCAL YEAR 2025 GENERAL FUND.

WHEREAS, Hurricane Ian and Hurricane Nicole inflicted severe impacts to Florida resulting in a presidential declaration for federal assistance in St. Johns County; and

WHEREAS, the County sustained damages from the hurricanes and is responsible for repairs to public property; and

WHEREAS, the County executed a contract with First Line Coastal on July 25,2024 for the project development, design, permitting, and construction administration of the South Ponte Vedra Beach FEMA Cat G project; and

WHEREAS, an additional need to permit a sand source for the South Ponte Vedra Beach FEMA Cat G project has been identified and will cost \$90,000; and

WHEREAS, it is estimated that the County will receive up to \$67,500 from a Department of Homeland Security FEMA grant related to Hurricanes Ian and Nicole; and

WHEREAS, it is estimated that the County will receive up to \$11,250 from a State of Florida Division of Emergency Management grant; and

WHEREAS, it is estimated that the County's local share will be \$11,250; and

WHEREAS, the County did not anticipate either an award of a Department of Homeland Security FEMA grant or a State of Florida Division of Emergency Management grant related to Hurricanes Ian and Nicole during the Fiscal Year 2024 budget process; and

WHEREAS, the County must recognize and appropriate \$67,500 from a FEMA grant, \$11,250 from a State of Florida Division of Emergency Management grant, and \$11,250 as the County's local share within the collective Fiscal Year 2025 General Fund.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida:

- 1. The above recitals are hereby adopted as legislative findings of fact and incorporated herein.
- 2. The Board of County Commissioners recognizes and appropriates a tentative Department of Homeland Security FEMA grant for up to \$67,500, a tentative State of Florida Division of Emergency Management grant for up to \$11,250 reliated to

- Hurricanes Ian and Nicole, and \$11,250 as the County's local share within the Fiscal Year 2025 Budget.
- 3. To the extent there are typographical errors that do not substantively change the tone, tenor, or concept of this resolution, this resolution may be revised without subsequent approval by the Board of County Commissioners.
