

RESOLUTION NO. 2025- 497

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2026 GENERAL FUND TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNANTICIPATED REVENUE AND AUTHORIZE ITS EXPENDITURE BY THE LIBRARY SYSTEM.

RECITALS

WHEREAS, the St. Johns County Fiscal Year 2026 operating budget was prepared prior to determining the total amount of donations that would be received by the St. Johns County Public Library System (“Library System”); and

WHEREAS, in the current Fiscal Year 2026 Library Services has received unanticipated donations in the amount of \$7,200.00.

WHEREAS, the Library System seeks recognition of the total amount of donated funds \$7,200.00 as current year revenues to enable the appropriation of such funds for use.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, that:

1. The above Recitals are hereby adopted as legislative findings of fact.
2. The General Fund revenue and the Library System expenditure budgets shall be adjusted to account for unanticipated revenue in the amount of \$7,200.00.
3. To the extent that there are typographical, and/or administrative, errors and/or omissions that do not change the tone, tenor, or context of this Resolution, then this Resolution may be revised without subsequent approval of the Board of County Commissioners.
4. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of execution.

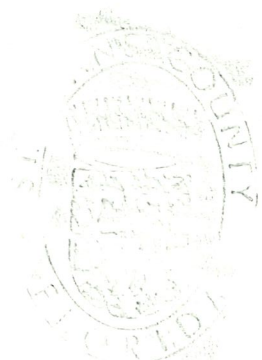
