In accordance with Florida Statutes 125.0104 and SJC Ordinance 1996-71, the SJC Tourist Development Council (TDC) is required to have two elected municipal officials on the council. The seat held by a City of St. Augustine Beach representative has expired. Please find attached for review and consideration a letter from Max Royle, City Beach Manager, requesting Vice Mayor Don Samora be appointed as the City of St. Augustine Beach representative on the TDC, along with a completed application from Vice Mayor Samora. In addition to this appointment recommendation, there are currently three other vacancies on the TDC due to a resignation and two expired terms. Two vacancies are required to be held by an owner or operator of tourist accommodations subject to bed tax. The third seat may be filled by either an individual involved in a tourist-related business other than accommodations or an owner or operator of tourist accommodations subject to bed tax. These vacancies were advertised in September 2020 for a fourweek span. TOURIST DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL

The Council meets at 1:30 p.m. the third Monday of every month in the County Auditorium. The Tourist Development Council is comprised of nine members appointed by the Board of County Commissioners. Three (3) are elected officials including the Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners, or their designee, and two elected municipal officials, one of which must be from the County's most populous municipality. Up to four (4) members (but not less than 3 members) are owner/operators of tourist accommodations which are subject to bed tax. The remaining members are persons involved in tourist related businesses other than accommodations. All members must be electors of St. Johns County.

On behalf of the Tourist Development Council (TDC), I respectfully request the appointment of four (4) TDC member seats be place on an upcoming Board of County Commissioners meeting agenda.

Two of the TDC seats, previously held by Mr. Tom Manno and Mr. Irving Kass, are required to be held by a qualified representative from the accommodations industry. A recommendation was made by the TDC during the December 7th meeting, to appoint Mr. Joe Finnegan, owner/operator of the St. Francis Inn and Casa de Suenos Inn, and Mr. Charles Robles, General Manager for The Collector Luxury Inn and Gardens, to these seats each for a full four-year term.

The third seat, previously held by Mr. Jack Peter, may be filled by either a qualified representative from the accommodations industry or an individual 'involved' in the tourist industry. A recommendation was made by the TDC during the December 7th meeting, to appoint Ms. Kathy Fleming, Executive Director of the St. Augustine Lighthouse and Maritime Museum to the seat for a full four-year term.

The fourth seat is currently held by Commissioner Undine George, City of St. Augustine Beach. This seat is required to be filled by an elected municipal official. The City of St. Augustine Beach has indicated that they desire to have Vice Mayor Donald Samora serve as their representative going forward and a letter from the City of St. Augustine Beach as well as an application from Mr. Donald Samora are enclosed. Mr. Samora's service on the TDC is contingent upon his continued representation of the City of St. Augustine Beach as an elected official.





Please accept this letter as a supplement to my application for the "Non-Accommodation" position with the TDC. In order to demonstrate my involvement and interest in tourist related businesses, I am providing the following information:

I commissioned a "White Paper" in 2019, at considerable expense, to help explain and demonstrate how the County and the City could work together to arrive at solution to allow Airbnb's and Vacation Rentals to continue to operate and accommodate visitors and tourism. The study gave step-by-step instructions and highlighted how other communities have navigated these same issues. That paper was presented to the County and the City at no cost. I volunteered to continue any support that would be needed to resolve the issues which go to the core of tourism.

I attended several St Johns County Commission meetings as well as the City of St Augustine Commission meetings when these issues were presented. One of the County Commission meetings I attended was held to discuss the job that Richard Goldman was doing. He was being criticized for bringing too many tourists to the County.
