PRESENTATION BY THE METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION ON DEVELOPMENT OF THE TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (TIP) FOR FISCAL YEARS 2001-02 THROUGH 2005-06

Jeff Sheffield, Senior Planner, Transportation Planning Division, Metropolitan Planning Organization, gave a presentation to the Board of the TIP for Fiscal Years 2001/2002 through 2005/2006 for St. Johns County. (1:36 p.m.) Commissioner John Reardon entered the meeting. Sheffield walked the Board through the projects:

- County Road 210 - Resurfacing - Palm Valley Bridge to Mickler Road (1:42 p.m.)
Commissioner James Bryant entered the meeting.
- Greenbriar Road - Sidewalk - School at Switzerland to Foxhunt Trail
- I-95 - Add Lanes and Rehabilitate Pavement - International Golf Parkway to Duval County Line
- State Road 13 - Landscaping - Roberts Road to Davis Pond Road
- State Road 9B - Project Development and Environment Study
- State Road A1A - Add Lanes and Reconstruct - Mickler Road to Beginning of 4-Lane Roadway
- State Road A1A - Sidewalk - Country Club Drive to County Road 210 East (Corona Road)
- State Road A1A - Drainage Improvements - 0.5 Miles South of County Road 210 to Duval County Line
- State Road A1A - Traffic Signals - at Library Boulevard

Discussion was held on MPO boundaries, switching sections of road, funding of grant moneys, application of grant moneys, bicycle lanes, landscaping, street lighting, medians, and various other aspects of the TIP. Sheffield and Staff answered questions from the Board.
