1. EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT UPDATE

Wanchick reported that there had been no change within the County. He noted that the State of Florida had extended the State's Emergency Declaration for an additional 60 days and FEMA had extended the certification deadline for Public Assistance and temporary housing; and he recommended the extension of the Declaration of Local State of Emergency.

(8:02 a.m.) Locklear stated that the debris pick-up was anticipated to be completed by Thanksgiving. Discussion ensued on the sporadic nature of the debris pick-up and the patience of the residents. Locklear encouraged residents to notify the County of areas that were still in need of debris removal.

(8:08 a.m.) Johns said it would be helpful for the homeowners to know which company picked up bagged debris and un-bagged debris. Additionally, Johns requested a summary, at the next meeting, of the status of debris pick-up; where other counties were in their recovery; the number of trucks being used for pick-up; and to supply the phone number for anyone to call with debris that had not been removed.


With there being no further business to come before the Board, Johns adjourned the meeting at 8:15 a.m.
