

## **SIMPLIFIED DISSOLUTION OF MARRIAGE**

### **THE FOLLOWING FORMS SHOULD BE USED WHEN FILING FOR A SIMPLIFIED DISSOLUTION OF MARRIAGE**

- 12.928        Cover Sheet for Family Court Cases
- 12.900 (h)    Notice of Related Cases
- 12.901 (a)    Petition for Simplified Dissolution of Marriage (Both parties must sign)

**BOTH PARTIES MUST BE WILLING TO GO TO THE CLERK'S OFFICE TO SIGN THE PETITION (NOT NECESSARILY TOGETHER)**

**BOTH PARTIES MUST BE WILLING TO GO TO THE FINAL HEARING (AT THE SAME TIME).**

- 12.902 (b)    Family Law Financial Affidavit (Short Form) (Income less than \$50,000 annually) (FROM BOTH PARTIES) or
- 12.902 (c)    Family Law Financial Affidavit (Income \$50,000 or more annually)
- 12.902 (i)    Affidavit of Corroborating Witness (or one of the following: Florida DL, ID, Voter Card)
- 12.902 (j)    Notice of Social Security Number
- 12.990 (a)    Final Judgment of Simplified Dissolution of Marriage
