THE FOLLOWING FORMS SHOULD BE USED WHEN FILING FOR A SIMPLIFIED DISSOLUTION OF MARRIAGE

- 12.928 Cover Sheet for Family Court Cases
- 12.900 (h) Notice of Related Cases
- 12.901 (a) Petition for Simplified Dissolution of Marriage (Both parties must sign)

BOTH PARTIES MUST BE WILLING TO GO TO THE CLERK'S OFFICE TO SIGN THE PETITION (NOT NECESSARILY TOGETHER)

BOTH PARTIES MUST BE WILLING TO GO TO THE FINAL HEARING (AT THE SAME TIME).

- 12.902 (b) Family Law Financial Affidavit (Short Form) (Income less than \$50,000 annually) (FROM BOTH PARTIES) or
- 12.902 (c) Family Law Financial Affidavit (Income \$50,000 or more annually)
- 12.902 (i) Affidavit of Corroborating Witness (or one of the following: Florida DL, ID, Voter Card)
- 12.902 (j) Notice of Social Security Number
- 12.990 (a) Final Judgment of Simplified Dissolution of Marriage
