If issue of modification involves child support and/or change of timesharing or parenting plan, then the following forms would be required:

12.995 (a) Parenting Plan

12.995 (b) Supervised/Safety Focused Parenting Plan

1. Prepare paperwork.
2. Both parties must sign and notarize.
3. File with Clerk.
4. Provide three (3) copies of the order (all filled out, except the portion reserved for the judge's signature and date) and two (2) stamped pre-addressed envelopes, (one (1) for each party) to the Clerk when you file the Joint Supplemental Petition.
