

JOINT PETITION FOR ADOPTION BY STEPPARENT

- 12.981 (a) (2) Consent of Adoptee (use only if the Child is over the age of 12)
- 12.981 (a) (1) Consent and Waiver by Parent (signed in presence of notary and 2 witnesses)

A certified copy of the child's birth certificate.

If the other party does not consent to the Stepparent Adoption you must serve the party by Sheriff with legal papers notifying the party of the court filing. If the other party is out of state, you must at the time of filing provide the Clerk with the address of the County Sheriff where the other party lives and the fee charged by the sheriff's office for the service of papers. The service packet will be given to the petitioner. The petitioner will mail the service packet to the County Sheriff (out of state only).

In the case of no address for the other parent you will need a notice of action and

- 12.981 (a) (4) Stepparent adoption: Affidavit of Diligent Search (follow the instructions on the forms and/or consult an attorney and/or call St Johns County Legal aid.
