**ORDER ON MOTION TO UNSEAL COURT FILE AND ORDER DETERMINING
CONFIDENTIALITY OF COURT RECORDS**

THIS CAUSE came before the Court at a Case Management Conference on October 18, 2023. On October 3, 2023, the Wife filed a Motion to Unseal Court File and/or Determine Record Confidential Pursuant to Rule 2.420(e), Fla. R. Jud. Admin. On September 18, 2023, this Court entered a Consent Order Granting Motion to Seal Confidential Records. The Clerk of Court sealed the entire file thus preventing counsel of record and the parties, as well as the public, from viewing the Court file. The inability to access the Court file has created difficulty in legal representation of the parties in this matter. Accordingly, it is


ORDERED AND ADJUDGED:

1. This is a dissolution of marriage action involving minor children and physician parents. The Court finds that the record is confidential because, inter alia, such designation is necessary to prevent a serious and imminent threat to the fair, impartial, and orderly administration of justice, avoid substantial injury to third parties, and avoid substantial injury to a party by disclosure of matters protected

by law or privacy right.

2. The degree, duration, and manner of confidentiality ordered is no broader than necessary and there are no less restrictive measures available to protect the interests of confidentiality as set forth above.
3. The Clerk of Court is directed to UNSEAL the court file and designate and maintain the confidentiality of all pleadings and papers in the record.
4. The persons permitted to electronically view the confidential records in this case are the parties and their legal counsel of record in this action.
5. The Clerk of Court is directed to publish this Order in accordance with Rule 2.420(e)(4), Fla. R. Jud. Admin.
