On September 15, 2026, during Commissioner comments, a motion was made by Commissioner Whitehurst to schedule a special meeting to bring back the item for reconsideration. The Application requests Agricultural Enclave Certification pursuant to Sections 163.3162 and 163.3164, Florida Statutes. This certification request includes approximately 615.41 acres and is located directly east of Interstate 95 and south of State Road 207.
